2019 Ribbon Ridge Pinot Noir

THE WINE. *The Willamette Valley is Oregon's most recognized appellation for cool climate wines, and it is in the Northern part of this Valley where the finest vineyards are found.*

Wines of the Origin Series are a reflection of the unique climates, geographical features, and growing conditions that embody each distinctive region where we source our grapes. Preservation of place is essential to our wine making philosophy, and in accordance with our environmental principles, all of the vineyards we work with are at a minimum certified sustainable.

Ribbon Ridge is defined by a serpentine backbone of ridge tops composed of fine-grained marine sedimentary soils. Pinot noirs from here consistently exhibit lush, dark fruit and noteworthy spice, while remaining structured with subtle acidity and fine tannins.
